Catch-Up Premium funding £26,610

The Year 7 Catch-Up Premium will be used by the Academy to deliver additional intensive support in small groups, giving students the support needed to bring them up to speed so that they are more likely to succeed.

The Academy are awarded up to £500 in respect to any student any Year 7 student recorded on the October 2018 census and recorded in the 2018 KS2 assessment data as **not** achieving the Department for Education (DfE) national floor standard of attainment in reading or mathematics.

Catch-Up Premium September 2017-August 2018 Allocation
